- RULES OF PLAY:**                      High School Girl Rules Apply for Girls, High School Boy Rules Apply for Boys (Exceptions) These exceptions apply for both Boys and Girls.  
\* Ball size. Girls - 28.5 Boys 9/U3<sup>rd</sup> thru 12/U 6<sup>th</sup> - 28.5 Boys 13/U 7<sup>th</sup> thru 17/U 11<sup>th</sup> Mens Regulation Size  
\* No shot clock. 10 second back court violation.  
\* On all free throws, players shall not enter lane until ball contacts rim.  
\* Technical fouls results in (2) shots and the ball.  
\* No jewelry, plastic bracelets, ear rings, etc...shall be worn by players.  
\* Team may start game with 4 players.  
\* Games for all divisions will be (7) minute quarters stop clock.  
\* (3-5) minute warm-up and halftime.

- GAME GUARANTEE:**                      Each team will receive a 3 game guarantee. Some teams may receive (4). TBA
- FORMAT:**                                    Depending on the total number of teams entered.  
3-5 teams (round robin) 6-7 teams (pool play) 8 or more (bracket play)
- AAU MEMBERSHIP:**                      All athletes, coaches and bench personal must hold a current membership in the AAU. This will be part of the check-in process. Any athlete or coach without acceptable proof of membership will be required to purchase membership at the site to participate.

**AWARDS:** \* Individual awards will be given to players that are present at the championship game only. If there are only 4 or 5 teams in any division only the 1st place team will be awarded. If there are 6 teams in any division then 1st and 2nd place teams will be awarded. If there are 8 teams in any division, there will be 3rd place awards.

**CHECK IN PROCESS:** There is no formal check-in. Coaches will sign in at the gym of their 1<sup>st</sup> game. TBA. All Coaches / Team leaders should have players and coaches AAU cards, player birth certificates and grade exception forms with them at the tournament. In the event of a protest, you must provide proof of age/grade at the event.

**ADMISSION:**

- \* Admission will be charged each day at all gyms. (\$5.00 for ages 15yrs. & Up), (\$3.00 for ages 6yrs. - 14yrs.), (ages 5 & under are free)
- \* Coaches must sign in at the door of their first game each day to receive their wristband. A maximum of (2) coaches will be given wristbands.
- \* Coaches must have current AAU membership cards. Additional coaches will be required to pay admission.
- Coach's must wear their wristbands at all times at tournament. All Coach's must be registered with AAU.

**Sac Area Sports Inc. Disruptive Behavior or Fighting Policy**

Any player involved in fighting, spitting, or provoking behavior towards any person, on or off the court, during a Sac Area Sports Event, shall be suspended for all remaining games of that tournament and shall not be allowed to participate in the following tournament. Any spectator involved in fighting (physical contact with another), spitting, or provoking behavior towards another person during a Sac Area Sports Event, shall not be allowed in or around any gym of the event being held. Also shall not be allowed back to future events. Absolutely no profanity from spectators, players or coaches. Any spectator that is causing a problem, (verbally) shall be asked to leave the gym, by lead official or site director. (must be a way from any entrance or exit of gym) That spectator shall be allowed back to future games. Lead official or Site Director has the right to ask any person to leave the gym site. If that person does not leave immediately, 911 shall be called.
